Items

Description

How to sort

Cardboard



All cardboard boxes, e.g. pizza boxes.

Flatten boxes to save space. Place directly into the **Green bin**

Newspapers/magazines



Newspapers, magazines, junk mail, envelopes and office paper, etc.

Directly into the **Green bin**

Tetrapacks/cerealboxes



Beverage cartons e.g. Tetrapak, cereal boxes and all other carton packages.

Remove food residue and rinse beverage cartons and flatten. Place directly into the **Green bin** Good to place many cartons inside one.

Plastics



All kinds of soft and hard plastic packaging, e.g. bags, film, bottles and containers.
No styrofoam

Rinse all plastic packaging. Place small items into the **Green bin** clear plastic bags. Place bigger parts directly into the **Green bin**

Metals



Small metal parts, e.g. steel and tin cans, aluminium foil, jarlids etc.

Rinse aluminium and tin cans. Place directly into the **Green bin**



FOOD WASTE

BROWN BIN



Food waste

The **Brown bin** is for all food waste and other biodegradable waste from households. It is very important to put the biodegradable waste into biobags (Maispokinn) before it is disposed into the **Brown bin**.

Example of waste that can be put into the **Brown bin**:



Fruits



Vegetables



Bread



Rice, corn etc.



Coffee grounds and filters



Cheese



Fish



Eggs and eggshells



Tea bags



Meat



Pasta



Toothpicks



Flowers



Tissue paper/napkins
